Four Vehicle Accident Results In Injuries

A Lincoln woman was injured in a four vehicle pile up on Route T just north of Dick Road in Benton County on March 10 at 7:55 PM.

The accident occurred when a 1998 Chevrolet driven by Ron Peters, 66, of Kansas City overtook and struck the rear end of a John Deere 6420 driven by Kathryn Simkins, 70, of Lincoln.

After impact, the Peters' vehicle then struck a 2015 Ford Transit van driven by Alan Gibler, 54, of Columbia. Next a 2008 Chevrolet Impala driven by a 17 year

old female from Warsaw struck the Peters' vehicle which was stopped in the roadway.

Simpkins was taken to Golden Valley Hospital in Clinton with moderate injuries.

Peters was transported to Research Hospital in Kansas City with moderate injuries.
